



## Signing of Memorandum of Cooperation with InnoEnergy and JETRO

On Tuesday, September 16, 2025, GX Acceleration Agency (GXA) signed a Memorandum of Cooperation (MOC) with InnoEnergy and Japan External Trade Organization (JETRO) to build and strengthen domestic and international innovation ecosystems in the field of Green Transformation (GX).

To achieve carbon neutrality by 2050, it is indispensable to expand the adoption of existing technologies and promote the social implementation of new technologies that accelerate GX. In collaboration with InnoEnergy and JETRO, GXA has signed a Memorandum of Cooperation (MOC) to build and strengthen domestic and international innovation ecosystems in the GX field.

This MOC is based on the "Japan-EU Competitiveness Alliance" signed between the Government of Japan and the EU in July of this year, and its main points are as follows:

<Key Initiatives under the MOC (Overview)>

- Collaboration in information exchange and financial support for startups in the cleantech field,
- Exchange of information on market conditions and policies related to cleantech in Japan and the EU,
- Facilitation of business cooperation of startups, investors, and other private companies in the cleantech field,
- Co-organization of and participation in mutual activities with the main objective of networking and information exchange.

InnoEnergy is an organization under the European Institute of Innovation & Technology (EIT), which was established by the EU to enhance Europe's innovation capabilities. It is actively involved in investing in startups in the cleantech field, developing innovation ecosystems, fostering human capital, and building a global network.

Collaboration with InnoEnergy is expected to support the growth of startups possessing GX related technologies in both Japan and the EU. In addition, JETRO will complement this initiative by providing regulatory and business support, helping to establish a cooperative framework among the three parties.



Leveraging the network established through this MOC, GXA will contribute to building and strengthening domestic and international innovation ecosystems in the field of GX, while continuing to support the social implementation of emerging GX technologies.
